Mokhtar, Dean of the Faculty of Computing and Information Sciences, and their PhD student, Wafaa M.A. Habib got their latest publication entitled "Discovering top-weighted k-truss communities in Large Graphs" published in the "Journal of Big Data" with a high impact factor of 10.835.

STDF grants Prof. Amr Elmasry 1.2M pounds

Prof. Amr Elmasry, dean of the Faculty of Engineering, has won a grant with 1,200,000 LE funded by Science and Technology Funding Authority (STDF), with the project title "Basic Graph Theoretic Algorithms". Through this project, Prof. Elmasry investigates some basic graph theoretic problems and tries to devise efficient algorithms to solve them, assuming an underlying modern model of computation. The expected solutions would mostly be theoretical, possibly implementing some of the expected outcomes for verification purposes.



Dr. Amal Elgammal is participating in the H2020 EU-funded project QUALITOP



Dr. Amal Elgammal, Associate professor at the Faculty of Computing and Information Sciences and Acting Head of the Software Engineering Dept., is participating as an adjunct senior researcher at Scientific Academy for Service Technology (ServTech), Germany, in the H2020-funded project "Monitoring multidimensional aspects of Quality of Life after cancer ImmunoTherapy - an Open smart digital Platform for personalized prevention and patient management-QUALITOP". The project's total cost is € 5,196,772,50 and involves 14 European

participants and the General Hospital Corporation, Harvard University, U.S.A. Cancer immunotherapy has helped to advance cancer treatment significantly. However, two main challenges remain that hinder the path to better health and quality of life for cancer patients after immunotherapy. There is a need for predictive markers for immunotherapy-related adverse events and information on such patients beyond randomized controlled trials.

ITIDA grants Prof. Amr Elsherif 250K pounds

Prof. Amr Elsherif, a professor at the Faculty of Engineering, has won a grant with 250,000 LE funded by Information Technology Industry Development Agency (ITIDA), with the project title "An Underwater AR-based System for Marine Life Detection and Classification for Divers and Tourists", collaborating with Dr. Mohamed Saeed and Dr. Ahmed Soltan from Nile University. Through this project, Prof. Elsherif tackles Egypt's coastal regions as one of the major attractions for tourists. The Red Sea area is beautiful for its warm weather and being one of the best diving destinations in the world.
